

## Chairman Ishimura Awarded 'Commander of the Order of the Crown' by Kingdom of Belgium Fourth Person of AGC to be Awarded

Tokyo, July 13, 2018–AGC (Headquarters: Tokyo; President: Takuya Shimamura) Chairman of the Board, Kazuhiko Ishimura, has been awarded the 'Commander of the Order of the Crown' by Kingdom of Belgium. The award was presented by Gunther Sleeuwagen, Ambassador of Belgium to Japan, on July 11, 2018 at the Embassy of Belgium in Japan.

This marks the fourth person from AGC to be recognized with the same award, beginning with Hiromichi Seya (then Chairman) and Shinya Ishizu (then President) in 2001, and followed by Masahiro Kadomatsu (then Chairman) in 2010.
